



FRONT JUMPER

The Family Membership Badge should be 45° from the centre of the last S in SCOUTS to the centre of the badge and 50mm away.

The Royal Navy Recognition Badge (RN Badge) should be 45° up from the S in SEA to the corner of the badge and 50mm away.

The first Challenge Badge should then be in line centrally with the RN Badge and level with the top of the Family Membership Badge. The rest of the Challenge Badges should be placed as shown.

The Moving On Award should be central to the Family Membership Badge and level with the top of the RN Badge.

The Participation Badge should be central to the Moving On Award and 12mm above.

RIGHT SLEEVE

Group name tag should be central on the side of the arm and 75mm from the top of the shoulder when the jumper is on.

The District / County Badge should be 12mm below and central to the sleeve.

The Leadership stripe should be 75mm below the District / County Badge and central to the sleeve, this would leave a space if Patrol Badges were ever used.

A Group Award would be placed 12mm below the Leadership stripe.

LEFT SLEEVE

The first Activity Badge should be 75mm down from the top of the shoulder when the jumper is on and central to the sleeve, the rest should follow squarely, left, right and below and 6mm apart.

NECKERCHIEF

The Necker Badge should be sewn to form a diamond and 6mm from the edge of the grey band, centrally at the point and the Silver Cross placed centrally to the badge.
